The year's activities of IPS were largely influenced by regional and international developments, most notably the illegal annexation of Indian-Occupied Kashmir by India on August 5, 2019, as well as the sudden outbreak of Coronavirus that brought the world to a complete halt. The Institute was however quick to respond to both types of developments, realigning its activities and readjusting its focus accordingly and timely. Thus, looking at the statistics, the Institute's total number of activities in the year increased to 273 from 254 in the previous year. Besides, the proportion of IPS' completed or continued-as-planned activities also increased from 73% in the last year to 82% this year.

Within days of India's action of August 5, 2019, IPS formed a dedicated working group on Kashmir (IPS-WGK) comprising relevant intellectuals, scholars and field experts with a view to analyze and advise policy options and viable strategies over the disputed issue. The working group held seven insightful meetings over the course of next 10 months, deliberating on latest situations, generating recommendations and sharing their valuable inputs with policy circles, key opinion leaders and other concerned stakeholders.

Other than that, the Institute also held three international seminars - Post 5 August Reporting of Kashmir with Special Reference to Indian Media; Kashmir: The Issue, Global Scenario and Policy Imperatives; and The Crisis in Kashmir:

Amidst Regional and Global Dynamics, in a bid to discuss the matter from miscellaneous angles. The third international seminar was held in Muzaffarabad, which in fact was the first such event in the history of the Azad State of Jammu & Kashmir in which international speakers and delegates were also taken to refugee camps and were separately hosted by the AJK president and speaker of the legislative assembly in two memorable receptions.

In addition, IPS also attempted to have a look at different situations and circumstances prevailing within India, trying to understand the causes as well as local and regional implications of its supremacist and imperialist designs through its sessions on Babri Masjid verdict, Kulbhushan Yadav's verdict as well as a two-part international webinar series on India's past, present and future, and its perception in the Muslim World.

There were a number of other important regional and global developments as well that came under the Institute's spotlight including Afghanistan's presidential elections, US-Taliban deal, the deteriorating situation between Iran and the US following the assassination of the former's general, the emerging dynamics in the Middle East, and maritime diplomacy in the modern world.

Muslim response, Islam in contemporary societies, Islam and Humanitarian Principles, and religious minorities in Pakistan were also some of the issues that IPS covered within its thematic area of Faith & Society during the period.

A number of other policy dialogues held during the year covered some important dimensions of Pakistan's internal affairs such as national agriculture and food security, GMO scene in Pakistan, the fourth industrial revolution, nuclear technology of Pakistan, federal budget review, prospects and challenges of IMF program for Pakistan, uniform education system, critical analysis of Transgender Act 2018, and myths and realities behind forced faith conversions in Pakistan. An ongoing series being organized in collaboration with the Council of Islamic Ideology also continued to highlight the role of the personalities like Allama Mohammad Asad and Justice Rana Bhagwandas in strengthening the ideological foundations of Pakistan.

In response of Covid19 and its consequent lockdown, IPS initiated a webinar series 'Covid-19: Global Challenge, National Response', each session of which was addressed by a subject specialist studying the crisis from his area of expertise. The eleven sessions held as a result of this rigorous exercise covered some important aspects of the crisis including its economic impact, socio-political repercussions, changing dynamics in international relations, subsequent global oil crisis. and strategic recommendations to minimize the losses incurred as well as to tap the opportunities coming forth. Two policy monographs were prepared as a follow up of these sessions which were then shared with the concerned stakeholders.

Besides holding discussions on several topics within its premises, the Institute was also represented by its team members in a number of sessions held locally and internationally. Also, the Institute signed memorandum of understanding with six national institutions to cooperate in the areas of mutual interests, whereas IPS becoming a partner of

a Chinese network of 20 select Asian think tanks was another one of the period's highlights.

Three issues of *Policy Perspectives* were published during the year in a timely manner. New indexing agencies have been approached internationally for its outreach. Besides, digital publishing with Pluto Journals is also continuing. However, due to the ever-changing policies of HEC, which were in fact directly affecting the standard of the journal, *Policy Perspectives* was withdrawn from its accredited list.

IPS LEAD - the Institute's learning, excellence and development program - held two sessions of 'Brainstorming Research Ideas' under its initiative of *Indigenizing Policy Research in Pakistan*. The program also held 10 sessions of its new series *The Living Scrips* which aims at acquiring tacit knowledge from experienced practitioners of civil services and imparting it to the audience as a food for their thought. In addition, it also organized three team development trainings and three motivational sessions, apart from hosting 6 exposure visits in the period.

The year's research work at IPS came up with 21 insightful studies comprising briefs, articles, monographs and reports on varied but important topics. IPS Press – the Institute's publishing arm – on the other hand published seven titles in the period whereas six more are in the pipeline.

The Institute's sustained media outreach in the period saw it make over 600 appearances in the national print and electronic media, whereas its international webinars not only attracted sizable international coverage but also reached the top ten panel of Twitter's national trends.

The Institute's digital platforms of Facebook, Twitter and YouTube too were instrumental in extending its outreach, apprising audience about IPS activities through appealing written and audio-visual content, whereas all activities of the Institute were also shared with a host of relevant audience in form of four newsletters, twelve e-newsletters and an annual report during the course of the year.


Financial Resources: Inflow 2019-20
