

Year in Focus



The year 2020-21 witnessed some important changes taking place within the organization's operational structure with IPS' founding chairman Professor Khurshid Ahmad assuming the role of the Institute's Patron-in-Chief, Executive President Khalid Rahman being elected as the new chairman, and two new appointments being made with Ambassador (r) Syed Abrar Hussain becoming the Institute's vice chairman (academics) and IPS' governing body member Abrar Ahmed Magoon being elevated to the position of IPS' vice chairman (endowment).

The unusual circumstances shaped since the spread of Coronavirus in 2019 continued to hinder the Institute's work in 2020-21 just like everywhere else. The Institute's departments of administration, research, IT, finance and outreach - with the help of endowment committee and assistance of purposely formed research and seminar coordination committees – however remained resolute to ensure that the Institute could maximize its work within the realms of possibility. The challenges did not waver the Institute's determination towards its objectives, as the period overall saw 134 projects being undertaken by IPS, out of which 81 were successfully completed whereas 26 progressing as planned. The project completion rate according to these figures remained 79.85%, which was a touch better than the preceding year's rate of 79% when the total number of attempted projects was 195.


The academic year at the Institute carried over the impact of one of the most important developments of the preceding year, the illegal annexation of Indian occupied Kashmir. The continued oppression of Jammu and Kashmir (J&K) kept IPS' dedicated Working Group on Kashmir (IPS-WGK) engaged in studying ongoing developments in the occupied region in seven sittings, documenting the findings in form of a co-published report and putting forward recommendations for future actions in a separate policy brief.

The regional developments especially *vis-à-vis* Afghanistan remained one of the focused areas of the Institute's work in the period covering a range of issues starting from twenty years of US invasion of Afghanistan and its eventual withdrawal, to the country's relations with Pakistan and Turkey's role in Afghan peace process. The most noteworthy activity however was the exclusive talk of former Afghanistan Prime Minister Gulbadin Hikmatyar which was hosted by IPS during his visit to Pakistan.

The Institute's initiative of 'Understanding Africa' - envisaging to build an in-depth knowledge and multidisciplinary study on African countries - featured detailed sessions accentuating matters like Pakistan's role in UN peacekeeping missions in Africa, and analyzing Pakistan's relations with North, South, and West African states.

The other important activities held within the ambit of international relations encompassed discussions on the challenges for the new US president Joe Biden, Basic Exchange and Cooperation Agreement (BECA) between the US and India, Israel's aggression over Palestine, UAE's recognition of Israel and its implications and a policy brief

underscoring the merits and demerits of Israel's recognition by Pakistan.

There was considerable emphasis on maritime sector of Pakistan as well, holding insightful deliberations on blue economy, freedom of navigation operations patrol, maritime peace initiative, and the ocean, its life, livelihood and sustainability, apart from highlighting the multifaceted importance of the subject in the sessions held with the faculty of Karachi University and the students of Federal Urdu University of Arts Science and Technology, Karachi.

The Institute's Faith and Society desk came up with an insightful study Forced Conversions or Faith Conversions: Rhetoric and Reality, analyzing reports by various civil society organizations alleging forced conversion of minorities in Pakistan. The findings of the study then were not only deliberated upon in a roundtable session, but also presented at the Council of Islamic Ideology (CII) and discussed with the media students of Karachi University.

In addition, the issues like Islamabad Hindu temple controversy, minority rights in Pakistan, and South Asia's neo communal settings were also brought into deliberations by IPS Faith and Society desk, while three book discussion sessions were also held in collaboration with Decolonial Dialogue.

'Energy' remained a vibrant focus of IPS throughout the year, with the highlight being the exclusive launch of its study on barriers and drivers of solar prosumage in Pakistan at the NEPRA headquarters. Over all, the Institute produced five briefs and write ups mainly on the issues pertaining to distributed generation and solar prosumage growth in Pakistan, and organized one conference, two roundtables and six meetings on the topic during the period.

Single National Curriculum is another area which has remained under national focus of late, and IPS too delved into the debate with three policy briefs discussing its objectivity, medium of instruction and religious content with reference to the Suddle Commission's report. Apart from this, a policy brief urging for reconsideration of HEC policy on PhD programs was also prepared.

Under the Institute's economy desk, the most noteworthy activity was the exclusive briefing at CPEC Authority headquarters by CPEC Authority chairman Lt. General (r) Asim Saleem Bajwa on the progress and challenges faced by CPEC. The desk also organized a session attempting to understand the 'State Bank Amendment Bill 2021', later following it up with a policy brief, besides recommending considerations for federal budget 2021-22 and then later reviewing the proposed budget from different angles.

Agriculture being a vital part of Pakistan's economy, was another area covered by IPS at length. The important activities held under this umbrella included a webinar, a policy brief and a monograph on national food security, as well as a roundtable on community rehabilitation through agriculture and health sector reforms.

The launch of Non-Resident Fellowship (NRF) program was another noteworthy initiative taken by the Institute during the period, seeking to take on-board senior academicians and research supervisors from various universities from across Pakistan and connect them with the government to bridge the policy-research gap. The first phase of the program saw the induction of four NRFs for the year 2021.

IPS was also represented by its team members in a number of externally held lectures, debates, discussions and presentations throughout the year.

IPS LEAD - the learning, excellence and development program of IPS initiated a pilot program Let's Talk Studio with an aim to contemplate over various issues concerning the country's youth, especially those topics which generally remain unaddressed. The initiative held seven interactive sessions of the program within a period of three months, before being discontinued to be relaunched later with revised branding and redefined scope. The already continued series The Living Scripts hosted 11 sittings featuring former civil servants and bureaucrats, whereas the Indigenizing Policy Research in Pakistan initiative co-organized two sessions of 'Brainstorming Research Ideas' in collaboration with Riphah Institute of Media Sciences (RIMS) and AIESEC-NUST.

IPS Press, the Institute's publishing arm came up with ten titles during the year, whereas its collaborations with Kube Publishing (UK) and Karachi University Press (KUP) enabled it to offer many more publications in the local market. Though there were no book fairs/exhibitions held during the year because of the pandemic, the addition of a dedicated digital marketing specialist paid considerable dividends. Another important development in this regard was the enabling of online payment gateway on IPS website, facilitating readers to purchase IPS Press publications digitally from any part of the world.

The archiving of the books of then IPS' chairman Professor Khurshid Ahmad was another highlight of the year. The

project so far has fostered content reproduction of five publications, out of which two have reached the printing stages. Another related progress was the work on a dedicated website for IPS' founding chairman, which once completed, will be featuring his profile and works on a single platform.

Besides collaborating with several notable institutions including Kube Publishing (UK), Karachi University, NUST, University of Management and Technology (UMT), ILKE (Turkey) and Pakistan Maritime Security Agency (PMSA), the year also saw IPS making regular appearances in print and electronic media both locally and internationally, extending the reach of its studies and findings to a much wider audience.

Apart from aforementioned publications, the research work at IPS produced two issues of its flagship research journal *Policy Perspectives* and work on two issues of its biannual journal *Nuqta-e-Nazar*, and one issue of the biannual periodical *Maghrib aur Islam* was also done.

Aimed at expanding its outreach, the Institute produced four newsletters, twelve monthly e-newsletters and an annual report during the course of the year, whereas its sustained following on social media platforms of Facebook, Twitter and IPS TV (YouTube), especially with the live stream of sixteen events on multiple platforms, played a vital role in keeping people engaged with the its activities throughout the year.
