Year in Focus



The year witnessed a number of initiatives and developments at IPS with a renewed focus on outreach and networking in the policy circles, academia and media. The ever-expanding list of policy issues needing urgent attention and evidence-based input demands that IPS must build a strategic community of scholars, analysts, practitioners, journalists and activists, which can collaborate for timely, well-informed, and well-deliberated responses or interventions, and proactively generate and/or influence policy-oriented intellectual discourses.

The Non-Resident Fellowship Program, and the Promoting Indigenous Policy Research Initiative (PIPRI) – under which frequent sessions of 'Brainstorming Research Ideas' for research students and their supervisors are being held, and research support is being provided to a number of PhD, MPhil, MS, LLM students, as well as public officials undertaking staff courses – engagements with university faculties for joint research, and collaboration efforts with international organizations, governance/policy consultants, ministries and authorities, 'The Living Scripts' series to record oral histories of veteran public officials, and capacity-building of media personnel on key issues are indicative of the new strategic thinking at IPS.

Compilation of Professor Khurshid Ahmad's lifelong contributions in book form, on some of the hot issues about Pakistan polity as well as Islam and Muslims, research and dialogue on Islamic Social Finance and Riba-free economy, Kashmir, Afghanistan, Pakistan's relations with African countries, CPEC and Pak-China relations, Central Asia, global and regional implications of Russia-Ukraine war, Pakistan's foreign policy conduct in the PTI government's period, Pakistan's ideology and constitution, decolonial/critical Muslim studies, caste, minority, gender & identity politics, maritime & coastal development, leadership & governance, and renewable energy remained the main focus areas at IPS during the year.

It is pertinent to mention that according to the guidance provided by the Institute's NAC members over the last few years, 'science and technology'

has also been included as one of the key thematic areas of IPS' work. Collaborations with a number of organizations and science and technology universities have been initiated in this regard under a dedicated program, functionally titled as IPSTECH.

IPS Press – the publishing and bookselling arm of the Institute – continued with bringing forth a number of titles and also contributed in generating some resources for IPS through the provision of editorial and publishing services to organizations such as Kube Publishing, UK, Riphah International University, and the Centre for Peace and Global Studies (CPGS) for new and reprint titles for distribution in Pakistan and neighboring countries. Despite economic instability, drastic cuts in library budgets and market challenges due to eroding purchasing power among readers and increase in input cost and subsequently book prices, the publications' sale has been quite encouraging.

The year also witnessed a challenging and stressful time for the operations (especially for finance and admin sections) team as IPS underwent at least five major audits and scrutiny: 1. The regular annual audit, 2. PCP (Pakistan Centre for Philanthropy), 3. FBR's special audit for an old inquiry, 4. Multiple inquiries and scrutiny by different government agencies for the EAD MoU, 5. A comprehensive system audit by GIZ to evaluate IPS for a grant for the Islamic Social Finance for Social Protection Policies in KP and Punjab. The increasing number of events (around 80) and printing projects (41 during the year) were also quite challenging for the team and IPS' resources.

Four major events in the year – including two in Karachi and one in Gwadar – among other activities, provided greater opportunities to IPS to share its insights with a wider international audience and network with prominent national and international scholars and thought leaders.

IPS also conducted field studies and surveys to collect primary data for different projects, the most significant being the work on the alleged 'forced conversions' of minorities in Sindh.

Year in Focus

The Institute was represented by its team members in several externally organized gatherings and academic events, extending and exchanging insights and institutional perspectives over correlating concerns, while a number of visits were also made during the course of the year to different universities, institutions, seminaries and public and private sector organizations with a view to increase the Institute's visibility and outreach, as well as to amplify the impact of its endeavors.

The research work of IPS over the academic year produced one issue of its flagship journal *Policy Perspectives* and three issues of the periodical *Nuqta-e-Nazar* (revived after a gap of five years), whereas another issue of both of these journals as well as one issue of another periodical *Maghrib aur Islam* was near completion.

Over all, the Institute undertook 102 projects in the year 2021-22, out of which 53 were completed in time, and 29 are progressing as planned. The completion ratio, which was 79.85% in the previous year, stood out to be 80.39% this time around.

The year's outreach efforts for the Institute resulted in collaborations, agreements and signings of MoUs with a diverse set of institutions, and garnered substantial coverage in print, electronic and online media spaces.

Speaking of the cyberworld, the live streaming of fifteen events managed to amass sizeable viewership whereas the Institute's social media platforms of Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, YouTube, Instagram and WhatsApp - alongside the conventional means of IPS newsletters, e-newsletters and annual report - remained instrumental in keeping the audience informed about all IPS announcements, initiatives and ongoing activities.

While this progress offered quite a bit for all IPS' departments and workforce to be happy about, the Institute also had to endure a setback when its senior research fellow Ambassador (r) Tajammul Altaf passed away following a brief illness. The Institute will always remember his association and services in shining words and will always be keeping him in its prayers and cherished memories.
