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Year in Focus

During 2023–24 period, the national scenario saw political uncertainty and realignments, increasing polarization, and instability in the country. The regional and global structures, alliances, and trends also witnessed major shifts. The principles, procedures, and the order of global governance became subject to severe criticism and polarization for sacrificing human lives, values, and ideals for short term political objectives. A radical change was more evident now in almost all societies, and the rise in Islamophobia, populism, and xenophobia significantly impacted political spectra and national priorities.

These conditions asked for a more focused, coherent, and synergized effort by IPS to develop and promote policy options and narratives to proactively engage policy practitioners, scholars, professionals, and activists. The market conditions, on the other hand, also caused significant restraints for the Institute. However, the IPS team remained

vigilant through the year to adjust to the realities on ground.

Realizing the needs and challenges, the Institute developed active collaborations with national and foreign academic organizations through collaborations for the promotion of indigenous policy discourses. The two-day national conference on '50 Years of the Constitution of Pakistan', in collaboration with the Fatima Jinnah Women University (FJWU) was a major highlight in which academics from Pakistan and abroad presented papers and several key figures from judiciary, government departments, legal fraternity, and scholars spoke as guests of honor. IPS was part of the 'First International Conference on Islamic Economics and Development' at the Quaid-i-Azam University (QAU), 4th international conference on 'Islamic Thought and Civilization' at University of Management and Technology (UMT), Lahore, and a multi-stakeholder seminar on child rights *viz-a-viz* climate change issues

at the Bahria University, Islamabad. Occasional collaborative activities with other universities, religious organizations, and professional training institutes have also remained a regular feature in addition to the above. IPS also offered patronage to and participated in the international conference on developing world order, held at the Institute of Political Science, University of Warmia and Mazury, Poland.

The academic contacts with Chinese institutions have continued to flourish. Apart from building on the contacts with our traditional partner Institute of South Asian Studies (ISAS), new collaborations developed with Research Center for Asian Studies (RCAS) in Haikou, Central Asia and South Asia Legal Forum, Kashgar, and a multilateral cooperative network of think tanks at the Research Institute for Indian Ocean Economics (RIIO) at the Yunnan University of Finance and Economics. IPS also entered into an MoU with the Chongqing Institute of Global Affairs (CIGA) for a research study on CPEC.

Changing dynamics in Afghanistan and their significance for Pakistan and the region at large required continued attention and deliberations. Apart from the above, IPS was able to discuss and develop timely response to the incidents of current affairs either on its own initiative or on the request from the relevant government institutions. These included discussions on the situation in Gaza and Kashmir, elections in India, Saudi-Iran rapprochement, SCO Summit, escalation and de-escalation between Pakistan and Iran, etc. Similar approach reflected with respect to the governance issues like State Bank of Pakistan (SBP)'s interest rate policy and inflation, IT policy, Iran-Pakistan pipeline project etc.

In the context of Faith and Society, the issues related to gender debate, rights of the elderly, child rights, and concerns related to women and minorities remained under discussion.

Decolonization of Muslim thought has remained an overarching theme, which reflected in the interventions on these subjects as well as several discussions and talks on education system, nation state system, and objectives resolution, organized in collaboration with national and foreign academic institutions.

Energy sector continued to be a focus where IPS has been able to develop synergies at international level. It is part of the international network of energy transition think tanks (INETTT) and has remained part of almost all its meetings and discussion including the one in South Africa. Digitization of power sector, decarbonization, and solar transition remained major emphasis of the work at IPS as well as these multilateral meetings.

The year saw five new titles, one issue of IPS journals *Policy Perspectives* and *Maghrib aur Islam* each, and two issues of *Nuqta-e-Nazar* brought forth. Besides, a gradual shift towards e-publishing and digitization also began to take place, opting for a smarter solutions to further utilize digital marketing platforms.

The live streaming of events managed to amass sizeable domestic and foreign viewership whereas the Institute's social media platforms of Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, YouTube, Instagram and WhatsApp – alongside the conventional means of media, IPS newsletters, e-newsletters and annual report – remained instrumental in keeping the audience informed about all IPS announcements, initiatives and ongoing activities.
